
Bromeliads

Neoregelia Bromeliads are plants that grow in sub-tropical or tropical conditions. Many are epiphytic, and can grow on the branches or trunks of trees. They get their nutrition from decomposed leaves or other organic matter, and the balance from the environment. There are many types of bromeliads. Neoregelias are just one group of this large family and are prized for their colourful leaves, which look like they have been splotted, striped or dipped in red, pink or white paint.
